Varietals: 50% Grenache, 50% Mourvèdre

Farming: SIP certified, glyphosate-free.

Production: 1246 cases

ABV: 12.9%

Èlevage: 11 weeks

Winemaking: The two varietals were harvested and vinified as one, and completed a long, slow, cool primary fermentation to retain aromatics. Upon completion of primary, the finished wine enjoyed eleven weeks on lees before a Saintly new-moon racking, and bottled February 16th, 2023.
